Overview

The use of multiple monitors is often preferable when running certain applications and Mouse Point™, the latest in KVM Switching technology from **Amulet Hotkey**, allows the user to shift the focus of keyboard and mouse data quickly and smoothly through multiple monitors and computers, without using hot-key or mouse button combinations. Mouse Point™ switching technology is intuitive to use and helps to keep you focused on the task in hand: you won't even know there's a KVM Switch between you and your computers.

Use this quick start guide to help you install the Mouse Point software on to your computers. Then use the embedded 'help file' in the Mouse Point application (see below) for a detailed explanation of configuration and operation.

Installation

You will find two installation files on the CD: a .exe installer and a .msi version. Use whichever version your O/S supports.

Insert the CD into the drive and select the appropriate Mouse Point™ installer. Follow the prompts until installation is complete.

Once complete you must restart your system. This process must be repeated for each PC connected to the K4u.

You can now program Mouse Point™ with your desktop using the configuration application. You will only need to do this once using **one** of the PC's connected to the K4u.

To access the Mouse Point™ configuration application, double click on icon (1) or open it through your program menu. It will be listed as a sub-directory of Amulet Hotkey. This will open dialogue box (2). You will need to launch Mouse Point Configuration (3) which will open the interface shown in the diagram (3a) to the right.

You can then use the K4u configuration application to build a graphical description of your desktop set-up and then load it into the K4u internal database.

Once complete, save your configuration file to a directory on your hard drive. Then use dialogue box (2) again to select the Update Configuration (5) option. This will load your configuration file onto the K4u.
